Citizenship

- The right to vote
- Ability to pass citizenship on to future generations
- Allows international travel
- Affords protection from the state



Residence

- The right to live, work, travel and study in a country
- Usually comes with conditions or requirements
- May give some travel rights
- Can be withdrawn
- Is likely to affect tax status

Purchase bonds for a minimum value USD 1 million from National Bonds. The investment should be held for a minimum of two years.



Investment of 2 million Dirhams in a Real Estate for a 2 year golden visa & Investment of 5 million Dirhams for a 10 year golden visa.
